I do a lot for Wymondham, and as deputy mayor I currently do put myself out there I do attend things as as a deputy mayor lately Welcoming the new vicar of Wymondham Abbey on behalf of the people of Wymondham.

I have assisted setting up three residents' associations in the new build housing estates in the Town. This enables residents to have a say in what happens with their neighbourhood. I am not scared of getting my hands dirty, and did that quite literally last winter, wading through puddles of (I will let you guess!) due to flooding around properties that have outstanding planning issues.
